ADMISSION CRITERIA:

Bourgade Catholic High School accepts applications from high school age students in grades 9-12 who are interested in pursuing a college preparatory education in a Catholic high school setting. While most students who apply to an international student program plan to study until graduation, Bourgade Catholic is open to international students who wish to study for one, two, or three years.

A student's academic history, SLEP or TOEFL test score, and information provided through recommendation letters are considered as part of the admissions process. Applicants who are considered for admissions will be issued an I-20 through the Roman Catholic Diocese of Phoenix. This will enable a student to apply for an F-1 student visa. A student must score a 48 on the SLEP test in order to be considered for admission.

* Class fees vary. The cost will depend on which courses the student registers for and whether or not class fees are applicable for those courses.

**Students who apply for admission to Bourgade Catholic High School via an organization such as International Exchange or DM Discoveries will pay medical insurance through that company. Students who apply for admission to Bourgade Catholic High School independently must pay the stated fee to obtain medical insurance. No student will be admitted without medical insurance.

***Based on a recent ruling by the Arizona Interscholastic Association (AIA), international students must wait a period of 12 months before being able to participate in the school's athletic program. AIA has also ruled that international students may not participate in varsity level athletics.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

June 15, 2012 FALL admission (August) – At this time Bourgade Catholic High School does not accept students at midyear.

All documents need to be submitted to Bourgade Catholic High School prior to June 15, 2012. Interested international students are free to contact the school to see if space is available after the given deadline. Delays in receiving necessary documentation may cause delays in the processing of the application.

PAYMENTS:

It is understood that tuition is due at the time the student(s) arrive to the school for the start of classes. Tuition for the year may be paid in its entirety before the first day of classes or it may be paid in two equal installments with the fall tuition paid on or before the first day of classes and the spring term on or before January 1st. Students are NOT allowed to begin classes in any term in which their tuition has not been paid. Once the student has entered his/her first day of classes, tuition for that term/semester is NON-REFUNDABLE. Payments for tuition and fees may be made by bank check or sent directly to the Bourgade Catholic High School bank account by wire transfer. Please contact Mr. Javier Bravo for wire transfer instructions.

STUDENT ARRIVAL DATES:

New students should be prepared to arrive by July 29, 2012
Returning students should plan to arrive by August 4, 2012
