



Bourgade Catholic High School 2012 Prom Dance Agreement

In order to promote a healthy, safe, and enjoyable evening, all students must read, understand, and sign the bottom of this agreement before a student pays for and/or attends the 2012 Prom at Bourgade Catholic High School.

Dress Guidelines-(Formal Dress)

Women

- Dresses must be knee length or floor length. Strapless or Spaghetti straps dresses are allowed.
- Low cut tops that show excessive cleavage or bare midriiffs are not allowed.
- Backless dresses must be at least waist high. Side Cut outs are not allowed.
- Dress shoes-Heels should be no more than 2 inches, make sure they are comfortable to dance in or bring another pair of dress shoes for dancing.

Men

- A tuxedo or suit must be worn (full length pants, dress shirt with buttons and a collar and a tie are required.)
- Dress shoes and socks must be worn.
- Hats that are rented with the tuxedo may be worn (no baseball hats)

***Note to all students and guests in attendance**

- All school dress guidelines must be followed.
- Visible tattoos and body piercings are not permitted
- This dress code applies to all students in attendance of the dance.

Student Dancing Behavior

Grinding and inappropriate dancing will not be tolerated

To promote a safe and healthy environment that honors the values of Bourgade Catholic High School, the following behaviors while dancing are expected: students are to dance appropriately; dancing and body contact shall be appropriate and should not contain any sexual gestures or movements. (Sexually-oriented dancing is inappropriate – this includes but is not limited to: students who are sandwiching each other, not facing one another, inappropriately touching each other or displaying any sexual gesture.)

Consequences for inappropriate dancing:

1. Verbal warning will occur informing the student that the form of dancing is inappropriate and they need to stop.
2. If a student continues the inappropriate behavior, the student will sit out for a song.
3. If a student repeatedly continues to dance inappropriately, the student may be asked to sit out the entire dance and their parents will be notified and/or asked to leave.
4. S/he will be allowed to attend the next dance only if one of the student's parents chaperone the dance.

Arrival and Departure

The 2012 Prom Dance will begin at 8:00p.m. and end at 11:00p.m. **Students must arrive to the dance no later than 9:00p.m.** Once a Bourgade Catholic High School student and guest enter the dance, **they may not leave the dance before 10:30p.m.**

I understand that dances are school-related events and all school rules apply. I agree to abide by all rules set forth in this agreement including the dress code and dancing expectations. I agree to wear a black t-shirt provided by the school if my attire does not follow the school guidelines.
