On November 10, 2011 Bourgade Catholic High School students will participate in our annual Walk a Thon. The Walk a Thon serves as one of the primary opportunities for the students to raise funds in support of their own education. It is a way for us to “give back” to help support the mission and vision of Bourgade Catholic. All 405 students will walk or run a 6-mile route through the surrounding neighborhood.

A portion of the proceeds generated this year will be used for Bourgade Catholic’s annual Mission Trip. Last year over 70 Bourgade Catholic students, parents and faculty made a trip to the San Carlos Apache Indian Reservation to build homes for needy families. In 12 years our Mission Trip participants have built 28 homes for the less fortunate in Arizona and Mexico. This clear demonstration of Bourgade Catholic’s commitment to serve the greater good also assists our students to see their place as citizens of a global world.
