After graduating from Bourgade High School, Sharon went on to Northern Arizona University and received a B.A. Degree In Education. She later received a Masters Degree from Arizona State University in Special Education and a Doctorate Degree in Curriculum and Instruction from Northern Arizona University.

Dr. Canady's educational service to the Phoenix Community has spanned forty years. Dr. Canady has been an Educational Leader in Arizona since 1970. to the Church financially and with her time.

For the past sixteen years, Dr. Canady, along with her husband, has been the co-owner of Accelerated Learning Center, an Arizona State Charter High School, dedicated to working with high school students who have been unsuccessful in traditional school settings and are off-track. ALC has helped many students to receive their High School Diplomas, and has done so while receiving an "A" Rating from the Arizona State Board of Education. As she did when she first began as a young teacher, Dr. Canady continues to work to "Make a Difference" for students and continues to be an advocate of students.
