As you may have seen this morning, Governor Doug Ducey and Superintendent (public schools) Kathy Hoffman released a statement announcing that the current public school closure will extend through the rest of the school year.

We will continue to follow the same course of action as before in awaiting direction from the Catholic Schools Office at the Diocese of Phoenix. Last week, our leadership team and faculty held a virtual meeting to address the possibility of remaining in a distant learning plan through the rest of the school year. If we find ourselves, again, following Governor Ducey's decision for the public school system, I have confidence that we'll share in a successful finish to the 2019-2020 school year.

As was mentioned in prior communication, graduation along with other end-of-year assemblies are top-of-mind as we explore alternative options should we find ourselves unable to celebrate those in their traditional in-person setting.
